APENDIX A THE ROOTS OF GRACE

Romans to Jude

These are what I called roots of grace (see chapter 1). These verses tell us what God has already done for us, to us, in us. They show us what already belongs to us. From the truths of these verses we can bear the fruit of them in our outward every day lives. We do this be faith. Faith means to believe that something has been done and is working for us and in us right now before we see it in the natural. Meditate on these verses and get them into your heart. Faith will arise and when you speak out of your mouth the truths contained in these verses in first person, present tense, watch the power of God be released to bear the fruit of these roots of Grace. Remember the root produces the fruit. These must be revelation to your heart first before faith can be released to see them manifested. Enjoy!

Rom 1:6 Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ:

Thank you Lord that you called me by Jesus Christ

Rom 1:7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called *[to be]* saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Thank you Lord that I am your beloved and that you call me a saint (a holy one). I believe I am holy.

Rom 2:29 But he *[is]* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision *[is that]* of the heart, in the spirit, *[and]* not in the letter; whose praise *[is]* not of men, but of God.

Thank you Lord that you made me a Jew inwardly. My spirit has been circumcised by your operation. My praise comes from you.

Rom 3:22 Even the righteousness of God *[which is]* by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

Thank you Lord that you have made me as right as you are by my faith in Jesus Christ.

Rom 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Lord I thank you that I have been declared completely innocent of all sin and guilt by a gift of your grace through the ransom price you paid for me at Calvary.

Rom 4:7 *[Saying]*, Blessed *[are]* they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.

I am now blessed because my iniquities have been forgiven and because my sins are covered.

Rom 4:8 Blessed *[is]* the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.

Thank you Lord that I am now blessed because you are not taking account of my sin.

Rom 4:25 Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.

Thank you Lord that Jesus was delivered over for death because of my offenses, but was raised again from the dead because I was declared righteous and innocent of sin.

Rom 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Thank you Lord Jesus that you made me righteous and innocent by my faith in you. I now have peace with God through you Lord Jesus.

Rom 5:2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Lord, Thank you that you gave me access by my faith in Christ into this grace in which I am standing right now. I am rejoicing in the confident expectation of your glory!

Rom 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Thank you Lord, that I will never be ashamed because you poured out your love into my heart by the Holy Spirit which you gave me forever!

Rom 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

Thank you Lord that I have been declared righteous and innocent by your shed blood. I am saved from your wrath in this life and the next.

Rom 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

Lord I thank you that even though I was an enemy to you, you exchanged my sin for your righteousness, and made me to be at peace with you. I have peace.

Rom 5:11 And not only *[so]*, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

I rejoice in you God because through Jesus I have received reconciliation with you.

Rom 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)

Thank you Lord that I have received abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness and I now reign as a king in this life by Jesus Christ your Son.

Rom 6:2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

Thank you Lord that in Christ I have died to sin and live no longer in it!

Rom 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Thank you Lord that you caused me to be buried with Christ in baptism and that when Christ was raised from the dead by your glory I was raised also and now I walk in the newness of your zoe life.

Rom 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with *[him]*, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

Thank you Lord that my old unregenerate man was crucified with and in you as my covenant representative. I declare now that sin in my body is rendered powerless and I am walking in and by your new life by faith.

Rom 6:7 For he that is dead is freed from sin.

Thank you Lord that I died with Christ and I have been set free from sin once and for all. I am free!

Rom 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

Thank you Lord that sin has no dominion over me because you took me out from under the law where I struggle to perform for you and placed me under your grace where you have done everything for me.

- Rom 6:17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.
- Rom 6:18 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

Thank you God that when I was a servant of sin, I believed from my heart that form of doctrine that was delivered to me which was grace, I then was made free from sin. Thank you that I am always free from sin when I believe from my heart what you have done for me in grace. I am your servant of righteousness.

Rom 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

Father, I thank you that I am here and now free from sin and I am your servant. The fruit of holiness in my life is born from the root of Christ in me and the conclusion of my life is everlasting life.

Rom 7:4 Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, *[even]* to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

Lord, thank you that I have become dead to the trying to live up to all your holy standards on my own effort but I rest in the sacrifice of your body. Thank you Lord that I am married to you so that through our holy union your fruit is born through my life to your glory. Rom 7:6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not *[in]* the oldness of the letter.

Thank you that I have been forever delivered from the principle of me trying to perform for you to obtain your blessings. The law held me in death. I am now serving you in the newness of my recreated spirit through faith and not in the old life of trying to live up to your written standards.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Thank you Lord that the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the principle of sin and death. I will not try to live for you but let your life live through me by faith and I praise you that sin is conquered in my life by your life!

Rom 8:3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Thank you that you already did what I have been trying to do all my life in my own energies. You sent your own Son for my sin and you condemned sin in my life. Thank you that I am free from trying to condemn my sin, but you did it for me and you enforce it when I believe it.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Thank you Father that your Spirit that raised up Jesus from the dead is dwelling in me and is giving resurrection life to my body to overcome sin right this moment. Praise you Father! Rom 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

I praise you Father that you did not give me a spirit of bondage to fear, but I have received the spirit of adoption. Through my new spirit I am now your legal and mature son and I cry out triumphantly, Daddy God!

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *[him]*, that we may be also glorified together.

Thank you Lord that because I am your child, I am your heir and a joint heir with Christ.

Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Praise you Father, that you predestinated me in Christ. You called me in Christ. You made me right in your sight. You also see me right now in your presence in the utter perfection of your Son in glory.

Rom 9:30 What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith.

Thank you Lord that through Christ, although I was a Gentile outside of your covenant and did not pursue you or your standards in my life, I have attained to a place of right standing with you and completion in Christ. I thank you that this comes by the faith you gave me in Christ.

Rom 11:7 What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded

Thank you Lord that I have attained what the nation of Israel is

seeking so desperately by all their efforts and careful observance of the law. I am righteous in Christ and everything you desired for a person to be. You did this by your grace in Christ. Thank you that I have been selected by you in Christ because you foresaw my faith in Christ. Thank you that you have opened my eyes!

Rom 11:30 For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief:

Thank you Lord that I have mercy now! I know that is why I can come to your throne of grace and obtain it!

Rom 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think *[of himself]* more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

Thank you Lord that you have given to me the same measure of faith as every one else that as ever existed in the Church. Thank you that I am not lacking in faith. I choose to exercise what I already have right now.

Rom 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, *[let us prophesy]* according to the proportion of faith;

Thank you Lord for giving me gift(s) by your grace to minister to others. I believe your word that they are in me and so I stir them up!

Rom 15:14 And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.

Thank you Father, that you filled me with goodness and knowledge in Christ. I now am filled with goodness and knowledge!

Rom 15:16 That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the

Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

Thank you Lord that you have set me apart holy by the Holy Spirit. I am holy.

1Co 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called *[to be]* saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

Thank you Lord that you set me apart holy in Christ Jesus and that you have called me a saint (holy one).

1Co 1:4 I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;

I thank you my God that you gave me grace which I possess right now by Jesus Christ.

1Co 1:5 That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and *[in]* all knowledge;

Thank you Lord that you have enriched me in everything including utterance and knowledge. I am rich in word and knowledge.

1Co 1:9 God *[is]* faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Thank you Father for you faithfulness and that you have called me into sweet fellowship with your Son Jesus Christ my Lord.

1Co 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: Praise you Father that by your doing am I now in Christ Jesus and that Jesus Christ has been made unto me wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption. I am wise, righteous, set apart, and redeemed by your placing me into Christ.

- 1Co 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.
- 1Co 2:10 But God hath revealed *[them]* unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

Thank you Lord that you have revealed to me by your Spirit those great things you have already prepared for me. I realize that I cannot understand them with my natural faculties but I draw them up out of my spirit man.

1Co 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

Praise you Father, that I have received not the spirit of this world but your Spirit so that I can know all the things that are freely given to me from God. I know all that I need to know.

1Co 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

Thank you God that I have the mind of Christ right now within me and I have access to your thoughts!

1Co 3:11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

Thank you Lord that the foundation of Jesus Christ has been laid in my life. I am now building on the basis on all that the Lord Jesus has already accomplished for me. I build on this foundation works of faith. 1Co 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *[that]* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

Thank you Lord that you made me your temple and your Spirit has taken up residence in my spirit which is your Holy of Holies!

1Co 3:21 Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours;

1Co 3:22 Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours;

I glorify and thank you Father that all things are mine! All things- the world, life, death, things that are now and things that are to come are all mine! I have need of nothing because you have provided it all!

1Co 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us:

Thank you Lord that by the sacrifice of Christ as my Passover that I am now unleavened, completed purged from all sin in my spirit man. I can purge out the sin in my flesh and soul by confession, knowing that you have purged out all sin out of my spirit.

1Co 6:11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

Thank you Lord that even though I once was a wicked sinner with no inheritance in Christ, I now have been washed by your Spirit in regeneration. I have been set apart holy, I have been declared right with you and complete in your sight in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of God. Thank you I am qualified right now to partake of the inheritance in Christ.

1Co 6:17 But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

I praise you Father that have joined me to the Lord Jesus and now we

are one spirit. The life of my reborn spirit is Jesus Christ!

- 1Co 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *[which is]* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 1Co 6:20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

I magnify you and thank you Lord that you bought my body with a price and it is now yours and it has become your holy temple.

1Co 7:23 Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.

Thank you Lord that you bought me with the price of your own blood. I am yours eternally. Thank you I am not subject to the desire and opinions of men.

1Co 8:3 But if any man love God, the same is known of him.

Thank you Lord that have been known of you, this is the reason I can and do love you.

1Co 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *[we be]* Jews or Gentiles, whether *[we be]* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

Thank you Lord that I have been baptized in the body of Christ and I drank deeply of the Spirit of Life and now my thirst has forever been quenched!

1Co 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

Thank you Lord that when the gospel was declared to me I received it by the faith you gave me. I now stand in and by this good news of your 1Co 15:10 But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which *[was bestowed]* upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

Thank you Lord that you have given me grace and by that grace I am what I am. It was not given to me in vain because I am working that grace out according your working in me.

1Co 15:34 Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak *[this]* to your shame.

I praise you God that you have given me a right standing and a right nature in Christ. I choose to stay awake and alert to that righteousness and grow in the knowledge of you by your Spirit through you Word.

1Co 16:23 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ *is* with you;

Thank you Lord that the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ has been given to me and is with me and will never leave me.

2Co 1:10 Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver *[us]*;

Thank you Lord that you have delivered me from so great a death in hell.

2Co 1:20 For all the promises of God in him *[are]* yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

Thank you Lord that all your promises are yes and amen because you already have given me them in Christ. I have all things that pertain to life and godliness.

2Co 1:21 Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, *[is]* God;

Thank you Lord that you have anointed me with the Holy Spirit.

2Co 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.

I praise you Father that you have sealed (authenticated, protected) my spirit with the earnest and first fruits of your Spirit. Thank you Lord that your Spirit is in my spirit.

2Co 3:6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.

Thank you Lord that you have made me an able minister of the new testament of grace. The Spirit ministers life as I minister the word of your grace to people.

2Co 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord *[is]*, there *[is]* liberty.

Lord I thank you that you caused your Spirit to dwell in my spirit. I am a spirit that has a soul and lives in a body. I am forever free! Thank you that I am free from the bondage of law and striving to achieve your standards in my own effort!

2Co 4:1 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not;

Thank you Lord that I have received this ministry of grace. I praise you that I have received your mercy so I will not faint today.

2Co 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to *[give]* the light of the knowledge of

the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Thank you Lord that you commanded light to shine out of my darkness, You have shined in my dark heart to give me the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the radiating face of Jesus Christ.

2Co 4:7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

I praise you Father that I have the treasure of your glory in my earthly body, so that the display of power in my life today will be plainly seen as coming from you and not me.

2Co 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:

Thank you Lord that your love compels me because I believe that since you died for me, I died with you. I am now dead to sin and to the law. I am alive with you in grace.

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man *[be]* in Christ, *[he is]* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Thank you Lord that when I received Christ I became a new creature in my spirit. The old spiritual nature passed away and I see by faith that all things have become brand new. I am now clean as a new born baby in your sight!

- 2Co 5:18 And all things *[are]* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;
- 2Co 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

I praise you Lord for reconciling me and making peace between us by Jesus Christ by the cross and have given to me the ministry of

reconciliation.

2Co 5:21 For he hath made him *[to be]* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Thank you Lord that you were made to be sin for me so that I am now your righteousness. Thank you that I am now as holy, pure, and righteous as you are because you are my holiness, purity, and righteousness.

2Co 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *[is]* the accepted time; behold, now *[is]* the day of salvation.)

Thank you Lord that you heard me and helped me in the day of my salvation and every day now is the day of salvation to experience your help.

2Co 6:10 As sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and *[yet]* possessing all things.

Thank you Lord that I possess all things in Christ. You have given me everything!

2Co 8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

Thank you Lord that you when you were rich, that you became poor, so that through your poverty on the cross I am now rich and prosperous. Because I am rich I give and it comes back to me in greater degrees and I become rich in the natural.

2Co 9:11 Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God.

Thank you Lord that I have been enriched in every thing so I can be generous to all and that the thanksgiving and praise all goes to you Lord. I am now rich.

2Co 9:15 Thanks [be] unto God for his unspeakable gift.

Thank you Lord for your unspeakable gift I have in your Son Jesus Christ!

2Co 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, *[be]* with you all. Amen.

Thank you Lord that you have given me grace. Father thank you for loving me. Holy Spirit thank you for your sweet fellowship.

Gal 1:4 Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

Thank you Lord that you gave yourself for my sins to deliver me from this evil age I am living in. I am now delivered from this evil world and its lusts.

Gal 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Thank you Lord that when I believed on you I was made right and complete in your sight by the faith you gave me.

Gal 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.

I praise you Father that through the law (Jesus' body in life and death

being the substance of the law commands and sacrifices) I died to the principle of trying to meet your holy standards in my own efforts. I am now alive to you God by and in your marvelous grace.

Gal 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ, and I live; *yet* no longer I, but Christ lives in me. And *that* life I now live in the flesh, I live by faith toward the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself on my behalf.

Thank you Lord that my old spiritual man was crucified with Christ and that old man no longer lives, but you now live in me. I live in my body now by the faith you gave me. Thank you that you loved me and gave yourself for me so that I am now joined to you in your life.

Gal 3:2 This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Thank you Lord that I received the Holy Spirit when I heard the message of grace and believed.

Gal 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *[is]* every one that hangeth on a tree:

Thank you Lord that you have given yourself as the ransom price to deliver me from the curse of the law. I praise you Lord that you became a curse for me on the tree. I am now delivered from the curse of the law which is all sickness, poverty, and spiritual death.

Gal 3:14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Thank you Lord that the blessing of Abraham has come upon me through Jesus Christ. I have received the promise of the Spirit through the faith you gave me. I am blessed! Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

I praise you Father that when I was baptized into Christ's body I was clothed with the son-ship robe of Christ. I am now your legal adult son able to partake of your inheritance Father.

- Gal 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,
- Gal 4:5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Thank you Lord that you came in the fulness of time and you paid the ransom price with your life so that I would be adopted as a legal and adult son able to partake of your inheritance. I am now your legal and adult son and I partake now of the inheritance!

Gal 4:6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

Thank you Lord that because I am a son, you sent forth the Spirit of your Son into my spirit crying Daddy God!

Gal 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Thank you Lord that I am no longer a cringing slave, but your adult son and I am an heir to your inheritance through Christ.

Gal 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

Thank you Lord that you have known me.

Gal 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made

us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

Thank you Lord that you set me free from the bondage of the law and trying to meet your standards in my own efforts. I stand in the liberty of your grace and righteousness knowing I meet your every standard for perfection in Christ by your grace.

Gal 5:13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only *[use]* not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

Thank you Lord for calling me into the freedom of love. I am free from sin and now free to love.

Gal 5:24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

I praise you God that by receiving you I have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. I see the flesh crucified daily by walking in fruits of your spirit and abiding in the vine. I allow you to live through me by faith and I choose not to try to accomplish your will in my own efforts but by faith in your grace which encompasses all that you have already have done for me in Christ.

Gal 6:14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.

I praise you Father that through the cross of my Lord Jesus Christ the world and its lusts are crucified to me and I have been crucified to the world and its lusts. I am now dead to the world and its lusts.

Gal 6:15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

Thank you Lord that I am now a new creation that has never existed before, created in true righteousness and holiness.

Gal 6:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *is* with your spirit, brethren! Amen.

Thank you Lord that your grace is ever with my spirit.

Eph 1:3 Blessed *[be]* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *[places]* in Christ:

I bless you Father because you have already blessed me with all and every spiritual blessing in the heavenlies in Christ. Thank you that these spiritual blessings give manifestation to every physical blessing in my life.

Eph 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

Thank you Father that you chose me in Christ before you founded the world. Because of Christ and because I am in Christ I am now holy and completely without blame before your penetrating eyes of fire and love.

Eph 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

Thank you Father that you predestinated me to the placing of me as a full, legal, and adult son that has the privilege to the full inheritance of the Father through your Son according to your good will.

Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

Thank you Father that by the glory of your grace and what you have done you made me accepted and acceptable in your beloved Son. Thank you for freely bestowing this on me by grace. Eph 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Thank you Lord that in you I had the ransom price for sin paid completely and forever by your blood. Thank you that all my sins past, present, and future have already been forgiven according to the riches of your grace (what you have already done)

Eph 1:8 Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence;

Thank you Lord that you have abounded to me your grace in every and all wisdom.

Eph 1:9 Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:

Thank you Father that you have made known to me the mystery of your will according to your good pleasure which has its purposes in yourself.

Eph 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

Thank you Father that in Christ I have obtained an eternal inheritance that I can partake of at anytime. Thank you for predestinating me in Christ for your purpose. Thank you that you are working that purpose in me now by the counsel of your own determined desire.

- Eph 1:13 In whom ye also *[trusted]*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- Eph 1:14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

Thank you Father that when I believed upon Christ you sealed me, 22

thus authenticating and protecting me with your Holy Spirit of promise.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Thank you Father that you have placed within me the riches of the glory of your inheritance. All that you bought for me and all that I need are already within my spirit man. Thank you Lord!

Eph 1:22 And hath put all *[things]* under his feet, and gave him *[to be]* the head over all *[things]* to the church,

Eph 1:23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

Thank you Father that you have put all things under the feet of Jesus and have given him to be the head over the church which is your body. I praise you my Father that since I am in your body then all things are now under my feet! I believe that I am filled with your fulness!

Eph 2:1 And you *[hath he quickened]*, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

Thank you Lord that when I was dead in my trespasses and sins you made me alive in my spirit and gave me a new life and start.

- Eph 2:4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,
- Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

Thank you Lord that you are so rich in mercy and love. You loved me even when I was a dead sinner and you made me alive with Christ. Thank you by your marvelous grace- all that you did saved me and still delivers me day by day. Eph 2:6 And hath raised *[us]* up together, and made *[us]* sit together in heavenly *[places]* in Christ Jesus:

Thank you Lord that you have raised me up with Jesus as my covenant representative and made me sit down with him in heavenly places in Christ. I rule and reign in this life with Jesus Christ with all things under my feet.

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *[it is]* the gift of God:

Thank you Lord that by your grace- all that you have already accomplished in Christ on my behalf- was given to me through faith. I realize that this faith is from you and not my own inherent goodness, power, or intellect.

Eph 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Thank you Lord that I am your work of craftsmanship and poetic masterpiece created in Christ Jesus. I thank you that you form fitted me for works that work out your master plan. I will do those works today. Praise you Father!

Eph 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

Thank you Father that now in Christ Jesus I am near to you because of the shed blood of Jesus on the cross.

Eph 2:14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition *[between us]*;

Thank you Lord Jesus that you are my peace with God. Thank you for breaking down the dividing partition of the law for me.

Eph 2:15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *[even]* the law of commandments *[contained]* in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, *[so]* making peace;

Thank you Lord that you abolished the hostility of the law and commandments in your body by dying on the cross. Thank you that I am part of the new man in Christ.

Eph 2:16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

Thank you Lord that you reconciled and brought me into harmony with the Father by your body on the cross. Thank you Lord that there is absolutely no hostility between me and you.

Eph 2:18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

I thank you Lord that I now have access by the Holy Spirit to the Father. Here I am Lord!

Eph 2:19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

Thank you Lord that I am no longer a stranger and a foreigner but a saint and citizen of heaven and of your Father's household.

Eph 3:12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.

Thank you Lord that I have boldness and access with confidence into the Father's presence through the faith that you gave me.

Eph 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,

Thank you Lord that you rooted and founded me in your love. Thanks for loving me.

Eph 4:7 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

Thank you Lord that you have given me grace according the measure of your gift. I have this grace and walk in it!

Eph 4:22 *namely* your having put off according to the former conversation the old man which corrupts itself according to the deceitful lusts;

Thank you Lord that I can put off the conduct of the old man. The old man was crucified with Christ. Therefore I am free from the habits of the old man right now!

Eph 4:24 and *your* having put on the new man, which according to God is created in truthful righteousness and holiness.

Thank you Lord that I have put on the new man when I was saved. I am a new man and I am truly righteous- complete, innocent, and meeting all the standards of God. I believe I am holy. Thank you Jesus for accomplishing this for me. You are my righteousness and holiness.

Eph 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Thank you Lord for sealing me, thus authenticating and protecting me by the Spirit of God. Thank you that you put down your payment on me and will come to get me lock-stock-and barrel at your appearance for the church.

Eph 4:32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Thank you Father that you have completely forgiven me of all sins past, present, and future for Christ's sake.

Eph 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savour.

Thank you Lord that you have and still do love me and gave yourself for me as an offering and sacrifice for my sin.

Eph 5:8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now [are ye] light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

Thank you that I am no longer darkness and in the dark stumbling around in sins and bondages. Now I am light in you. You are the light of my spirit that gives me light to walk in to not stumble and walk free from sin and bondages.

Eph 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Thank you Lord that you left me your armor to fight in. When the devil sees me in your armor he does not see me but you. I am an overcomer and have triumphed in you. I rule and reign with Christ right now! Thank you for your grace.

Phi 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform *[it]* until the day of Jesus Christ:

Thank you Lord that you began a good work in me the day I received you has Lord and Savior and I know that your Word is completing that plan in me everyday and I know you will never stop until the completion day of the project which is the day of Jesus Christ.

Phi 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;

Thank you Lord that you have graciously given me the gift of faith to

believe in you and also the gracious gift of patience to suffer for your sake, enduring the conflict of the flesh, world and the devil.

Phi 2:1 If [there be] therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,

I praise you Lord that there is consolation in you and comfort in your loving me and fellowship with the Spirit. Thank you for your compassions that are toward me.

Phi 3:20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Thank you Lord that my citizenship has been established in heaven. I am on the roll!

Phi 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Thank you Father that you are supplying all my need right now according the riches of glory that you have laid up in my spirit in Christ Jesus.

Phi 4:23 the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ is with you all. Amen.

Thank you Lord that your grace is ever with me.

Col 1:5 because of the hope that is laid up for you in the heavens, which ye heard of before in the word of the truth of the good news,

Thank you Lord that you have laid up hope for me in the heavens- a new body, new mansion, new name, and new occupation.

Col 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

Thank you Father that you have made me qualified right now to be a partaker of the inheritance of the saints in the light of revelation. I choose to partake of my inheritance now!

Col 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *[us]* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

I praise you Father that you have once and for all time delivered me from the authority of darkness and have transferred me into the kingdom of your beloved Son. I am delivered from sin and bondage!

Col 1:14 In Whom we have our redemption through His blood, [*which means*] the forgiveness of our sins.

Thank you Lord that in you I have had the ransom price paid for my sin by your blood. Thank you for forgiving my sins past, present, and future. I am forgiven!

Col 1:21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in *[your]* mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

Thank you Lord that you reconciled me to the Father even when I was alienated from you and an enemy of yours in my own mind because of my wicked deeds. Thank you that I now have peace with you and know in my heart and mind that you are at peace with me.

Col 1:22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:

Thank you Lord that through your slain body you presented me to the Father without blame or reproof in His sight. I am now unblameable and unreproveable in your eyes of fire and love.

Col 2:3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Thank you Lord that in you is hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge and you are in me and I am in you. I therefore have wisdom and knowledge in me!

Col 2:10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

Thank you Lord that I was made complete, lacking nothing in you. I am all that you intended a person to be in Christ. Thank you that I am in your body and you have put under my feet all principality and power.

Col 2:11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

Thank you Lord that in you I was circumcised by your operation when I believed. I thank you that you cut away from my spirit man the body of the sins of the flesh and I am dead to them and not dominated by them. I am dominated by my new nature in Christ in my spirit through faith. Thank you for the covenant of the new birth.

Col 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with *[him]* through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

Thank you Father that you buried me with Christ in baptism of death and that you raised me up to new life by the faith you gave me. Thank you for doing this for me. I walk now in new life and power; it is flowing in me now!

Col 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

Thank you Lord that when I was dead in my sins and the uncircumcision of my flesh you made me alive together with Jesus and you have forever forgiven my sins past, present, and future. Praise you Lord!!

Col 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Thank you Father that you blotted out the handwriting of ordinances that was against me and that I had broken, and nailed it to Jesus' cross and thus declared my debt to the law was paid in full.

Col 2:15 *[And]* having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Thank you Lord Jesus for spoiling and stripping naked the principalities and powers and making a triumphal procession openly disgracing them to the world. You are my triumphant Jesus and I triumph now in you.

- Col 2:20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,
- Col 2:21 (Touch not; taste not; handle not;

Thank you Lord that I am dead with Christ from the A.B.C.'s of do's and don'ts of life to find favor with you. I have favor through the finished work of Christ on the cross.

Col 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Thank you Lord that I have risen with Christ and I seek those things which are above where you are seated and I am seated with you.

Col 3:3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

Thank you Lord that my old man is dead and my new spiritual man is

hidden with you in the Father. I am double wrapped and protected!

Col 3:9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;

Thank you Lord that I have put off the old spirit man I used to be with its wicked deeds. I am free from them right now in you!

Col 3:10 And have put on the new *[man]*, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

Thank you Lord that in you I have put on the new spiritual man and I am renewed outwardly from the inside out by the revelation knowledge that I have been created in your image.

1Th 1:4 Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God.

Thank you Father that I have been hand picked by you in Christ. You wanted me, you bought me, and now I am yours.

1Th 2:12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

Thank you Father that you called me into your Kingdom and glory. Thank you for your grace to walk worthy of you, which is to walk in faith. I receive your power right now to walk worthy of you and believe as I act your power is released in and through me.

1Th 4:7 For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

Thank you Lord that you called me into your holiness in which I now have. From this root of holiness inside me I bear your fruit of holiness.

1Th 4:8 He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit.

Thank you Father that you have given to me your Holy Spirit by whom I walk in holiness.

1Th 5:5 Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.

Thank you Lord that when I received you as Lord and Savior I became a child of light and of the day. Thank you Lord I am no longer in the darkness of sin and bondage.

2Th 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

Thank you Lord that you have from the beginning of time hand picked me unto salvation through the Holy Spirit setting me apart and through my believing the truth of your finished work on the cross.

2Th 2:14 Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Thank you Lord that you called me to obtain your glory. Thank you that you already have glorified me!

2Th 2:16 Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given *[us]* everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,

Thank you Father and Lord Jesus for loving me and giving me everlasting comfort and a good expectation through your finished work of grace on the cross. 2Th 3:16 and may the Lord of the peace Himself give to you the peace always in every way; the Lord *is* with you all!

Thank you Lord that you give me peace always and in every way because you are ever with me.

2Th 3:18 the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *is* with you all! Amen.

Thank you Lord that your grace is with me right now.

1Ti 1:14 And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

Thank you Lord that your grace was exceeding abundant giving me faith and love straight from your heart.

1Ti 2:6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

Thank you Lord that you gave yourself to be the ransom price for my sin. I am free from sin and the claims of the broken ordinances of the law.

2Ti 1:2 To Timothy, *[my]* dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, *[and]* peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

Thank you Father that I am your dearly beloved son. Thank you for giving me your grace, mercy, and peace.

2Ti 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Thank You Father that you have not given me a spirit of fear or timidity but you have given me a new spirit filled with power, love, and saved thinking which comes from the mind of Christ. 2Ti 1:9 Who hath saved us, and called *[us]* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

Thank you Father that you saved me and called me with your holy calling, not according to my strivings and efforts but according to your plan and what you already accomplished for me by grace. I realize that you did this even before the world began because Jesus was the lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

2Ti 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

Thank you Lord that you abolished death by your death for me and brought new and eternal life to me by way of revelation when the good news of salvation was preached to me.

2Ti 1:14 That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.

Thank you Lord that the Holy Spirit dwells in me and I keep all that you have given me by Him.

2Ti 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

Thank you Lord that in you is grace. You are in me and I am in you. Your grace is in me and I am in your grace.

2Ti 2:11 *[It is]* a faithful saying: For if we be dead with *[him]*, we shall also live with *[him]*:

Thank you Lord that I died with you on the cross and I shall live with you at your second coming in glorious resurrection.

2Ti 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Thank you Lord that I have salvation through the faith you gave me in Christ Jesus. I look to your Word that gives me the light of wisdom to see that salvation that is already accomplished for me.

- 2Ti 3:16 All scripture *[is]* given by inspiration of God, and *[is]* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:
- 2Ti 3:17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

Thank you Father for giving me you Word so that I can profit from its doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction. Thank you that your word shows me that I have been perfected in Christ and that you have fully loaded me for this journey through life in order to do the works of Christ you have ordained for me.

2Ti 4:8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

Thank you Father that you have laid up for me a crown of righteousness because I love your appearing.

2Ti 4:22 The Lord Jesus Christ *is* with thy spirit; the grace *is* with you! Amen.

Thank you Lord that you are with and in my spirit and your grace is ever with me.

Tit 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.
Thank you Lord for giving yourself for me as a ransom price to deliver me from all iniquity. I declare that I am now free from all iniquity. Thank you for purifying me to yourself as a member of your special people. I am zealous for good works by the energy of your Spirit within me.

- Tit 3:4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared,
- Tit 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- Tit 3:6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

Thank you Father that your love showed up after my life of sin. I thank you that you had mercy on me, not by my own works or goodness, and washed me with the water of the new birth and renewing of the Holy Spirit. Thank you for flooding me with your Spirit and giving me a fresh clean spirit.

Tit 3:7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Thank you Lord that you made me righteous and innocent of all sin by your grace. I am now an heir of eternal life. I have great hope and expectancy in my life!

Phm 1:6 That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

Thank you Lord that the exercise of my faith is made energetic by recognizing and having revelation of every good thing that you have already deposited within my spirit.

Phm 1:25 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *is* with your spirit! Amen.

Thank you Lord that you are with and in my spirit.

Heb 1:3 who being the brightness of the glory, and the impress of His subsistence, bearing up also the all things by the saying of his might--through himself having made a cleansing of our sins, sat down at the right hand of the greatness in the highest,

Thank you Lord that you have made a complete cleansing of my sins past, present, and future and that you sat down at the right hand of the Father thus signifying your work is forever finished in redeeming me.

Heb 2:3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard [*him*];

Thank you Lord for accomplishing for me so great a salvation and deliverance. I am saved and delivered right now from sin and bondage!

Heb 2:11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified *[are]* all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

Thank you Lord that you set me apart as holy and that you are my older brother.

Heb 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

Thank you Lord that you have destroyed the devil and the power of death in my life. I have victory over Satan and all he possesses.

Heb 2:15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their 38

lifetime subject to bondage.

Praise you Lord that you delivered me once and for all from the fear of death. I shall die no more but have everlasting life.

Heb 2:17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto *[his]* brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things *[pertaining]* to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

Thank you Lord that you made satisfaction for my sins bringing me into a peaceful union with the Father.

Heb 3:14 For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

Thank you Lord that I have been made a partaker of Christ and the divine nature. I am steadfast unto the end. I am going all the way with you Jesus!

Heb 4:3 For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Thank you Lord for the rest you gave me when I believed. I choose the rest of faith. I rest in your finished works on my behalf. I will work while I rest and rest while I work.

Heb 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *[our]* profession.

Thank you Jesus that you are my great high priest and that you have passed into the heavens to represent me to the Father even right now.

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that

we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Thank you Lord that at the throne of grace I can obtain the mercy you have for me and to have an "eureka" experience when you show me what you have already done for me and already provided for my need. I praise you.

Heb 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

Thank you Lord that you are my perfect sacrifice and perfect priest. You wrote and played the main role in the redemption story and have achieved for me eternal salvation and deliverance. I give you my obedience of faith.

- Heb 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which *[it was]* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:
- Heb 6:19 Which *[hope]* we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

Thank you Lord that it is impossible for you to lie to me and you have given me a strong comfort in knowing that you are my hope that is in heaven and have anchored yourself to the throne of God and that I am connected to you with the strong rope of faith you gave to me. Each day I tug on the rope and am closer to the day I will see you face to face.

Heb 7:19 For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope *[did]*; by the which we draw nigh unto God.

Thank you Lord that you did what the law could never do. You made me complete and perfect in God's sight. You have given me a better hope than the law because you have already done it all for me. Because of this I can draw near to you in assurance of faith.

Heb 7:22 By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better testament.

Thank you Lord that your death, burial, and resurrection is my pledge of being able to partake of this better covenant of grace.

Heb 8:1 Now of the things which we have spoken *[this is]* the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

Thank you Lord that I have you as a high priest who is eternal sitting at the right of the Father.

Heb 8:10 For this *[is]* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

Thank you Lord that you have made a covenant with me through Jesus Christ and you have put your laws into my mind and have written them in my heart. I praise you Father that you are my God and I am a member of your people.

Heb 8:12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

Thank you Father that you were merciful to my unrighteousness and sins, and my iniquities you do not remember any more.

Heb 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption *[for us]*.

Thank you Lord that you have entered in by your own blood into the holy place and have paid the ransom price forever for me.

Heb 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the

eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Thank you Lord that through the eternal Spirit you offered yourself for me without spot to the Father and you purged my conscience from works that were in my flesh and self effort. I thank you Father that I can now serve you by my faith in your finished work.

Heb 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions *[that were]* under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Thank you Lord that you became the mediator of the new testament and by means of your death you paid the ransom price to pay for my transgressions. Thank you Father for calling me and giving me an eternal inheritance.

Heb 9:24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, *[which are]* the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:

Thank you Lord that you entered into the holy place of heaven to appear in the presence of God for me. You are my representative and intercessor.

Heb 9:28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

Thank you Lord that you offered yourself up once and for all for my sins past, present. and future.

Heb 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *[for all]*.

Thank you Lord that you set me apart as holy by the offering of your body once and forever.

Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;

Thank you Lord that you have offered yourself as a sacrifice for my sins once and forever thus sitting down completing eternal redemption for me past, present, and future.

Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

I praise and thank you Lord that by your one offering of your body on the cross you have forever perfected, completed, and made me all that you intended me to be in Christ. Thank you that in my temporal life you are working out what you have already done in my spirit and I am being progressively brought outwardly into the image you made me in my new spirit man.

Heb 10:18 Now where remission of these *[is, there is]* no more offering for sin.

Thank you Lord that there is no more need for any more offering for my sin because they have all been forgiven past, present, and future. I do have to pay for them by guilt, condemnation, and penance.

- Heb 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,
- Heb 10:20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

Thank you Lord that you have made a new and living way to the Father for me by tearing open the veil of your flesh which is the substance of the law that separated me from God. I thank that you removed this barrier for me on the cross. I enter with boldness into your presence Father by the blood of Jesus.

Heb 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Thank you Lord that you sprinkled me from an evil conscience of my inward man and washed and cleansed my outward man and actions with the water of your Spirit.

Heb 11:40 God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

Thank you Father that you provided for me something better than what the law could produce. You made me perfect and complete in Christ.

- Heb 12:22 But ye are come unto mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,
- Heb 12:23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

Thank you Lord that I have come to mount Zion and unto the city of God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to the company of angels and to you Father who is my Judge that vindicated me and to all the other spirits of men made complete and perfect. Praise you Lord that my spirit is now made complete and perfect.

Heb 12:24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than *[that of]* Abel.

Thank you Lord that you are my mediator of this new covenant and that you keep it active. Thank you that your blood cries out mercy on my behalf instead of justice and judgment.

Heb 13:12 Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people

with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

Thank you Lord that you set me apart as holy by your blood when you suffered outside the gate.

Jam 1:18 Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of first fruits of his creatures.

Thank you Father that you gave me birth by the Word of Truth. I am born of truth and I am of the truth. Thank you that I am a kind of first fruits of your creatures.

1Pe 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.

Thank you Father that you have chosen me by fore-knowing my faith in Christ. Thank you that you set me apart as holy by your Spirit so that I could really obey you by believing in the finished work accomplished by the sprinkling of the blood of Jesus.

1Pe 1:3 Blessed *[be]* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

I bless you Father that by your abundant mercy you have given me new birth into a ever living hope by the resurrection from the dead. Thank you for the resurrection life that surges my spirit being.

1Pe 1:4 To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you,

Thank you Father that you have reserved an inheritance for me that cannot be corrupted or defiled. Thank you for the first fruits of that inheritance right now which is health, prosperity, and freedom from the power of sin.

- 1Pe 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, *[as]* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *[received]* by tradition from your fathers;
- 1Pe 1:19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Thank you Lord that you have paid my ransom price not in money but by your priceless and precious blood. Thank you for being my sacrificial lamb. Now I am delivered from a vain life of sin to a full life of righteousness.

1Pe 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, *[see that ye]* love one another with a pure heart fervently:

Thank you Lord that my soul was purified by believing the truth through the revelation and power of the Spirit. I love others now with a pure heart.

1Pe 1:23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

Thank you Father that you gave birth to me by your very own seed of your incorruptible Word which lives and abides forever. Thank you that I will live and abide forever.

1Pe 2:9 But ye *[are]* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light:

Thank you Lord that you have hand picked me and that I am a king priest. Praise you Lord that you have called me out of darkness of sin and bondage and transferred me into you marvelous light of truth and freedom. 1Pe 2:10 Which in time past *[were]* not a people, but *[are]* now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

Thank you Lord that I am now one of your people and that I have obtained your mercy.

1Pe 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Thank you Lord that you bore my sins in your own body on the cross and I died to sins and to bondage. I now live unto righteousness and freedom. Praise you Lord that by your bleeding wounds and bruises I have been once and for all healed forever.

- 1Pe 3:18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:
- Thank you Lord that you suffered one time and forever for my sins past, present, and future and now I am yours and in your presence.
- 1Pe 4:10 As every man hath received the gift, *[even so]* minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- Thank you Lord that I have received a grace gift when I got saved and I will minister it to others with powerful effect.
- 2Pe 1:1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

Thank you Lord that you gave me your faith in salvation and that it is

the same precious faith that the apostles had. I have my faith in and through your righteousness.

2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *[pertain]* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

I praise you Father that by your divine power you have given me all things that are for my natural and spiritual life through the revelation knowledge of your Son Jesus.

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Thank you Father that by your glory and virtue you have given me exceeding great and precious promises that I can tap into the divine nature that dwells within my spirit. Thank you that I have escaped the corruption that is in this world through lust. I have been delivered from lust by faith in your promises that cause me to partake of your divine nature.

2Pe 1:9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Thank you Lord that I have been purged from my old sins and habits.

2Pe 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

Thank you Father for calling me and hand picking me in Christ.

2Pe 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *[both]* which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

Thank you Lord for giving me a pure mind in Christ.

1Jo 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

Thank you Lord that have become my advocate with the Father. You plead my case by pointing to the evidence of your scar-marks in your hands and feet and the blood that is on the mercy seat.

1Jo 2:2 And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for *[the sins of]* the whole world.

Thank you Lord that you were the satisfaction for my sins forever.

1Jo 2:13 I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *[that is]* from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father.

Thank you Lord that I have overcome the wicked one!

1Jo 2:14 I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him *[that is]* from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.

Thank you Lord that the Word abides in me and I have overcome the wicked one by the Word.

1Jo 2:20 But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.

Thank you Lord that I have an anointing from you and I know the truth

1Jo 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

Thank you Lord that I have received your anointing and it forever abides in me. It teaches me all things concerning the truth and will never deceive me.

1Jo 3:1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

Thank you Father for bestowing on me such an exotic and extravagant love that you call me your child.

1Jo 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

Thank you Lord that you gave me birth and I am right now your child.

1Jo 3:5 And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.

Thank you Lord that you took away all my sins on the cross past, present, and future and you purged them with your blood and now you and I are free forever from them.

1Jo 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

Thank you Lord that you destroyed the works of the devil in my life!

1Jo 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed

remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

Thank you Lord that you sealed your Holy seed in my spirit when I was born again and my spirit cannot sin.

1Jo 3:24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

Thank you Lord for giving me your Spirit forever.

1Jo 4:9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

Thank you Lord that you came and I now live through you.

1Jo 4:10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son *[to be]* the propitiation for our sins.

Thank you Lord for loving me so much that you came and became the satisfaction for my sins past, present, and future.

1Jo 4:13 Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.

Thank you Lord that I know that I dwell in you because you gave me your Spirit forever.

1Jo 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us.

Thank you Lord for loving me so that I can love you and others.

1Jo 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, *[even]* our faith.

Thank you Father that by giving me new birth you caused me to overcome this world. I believe I am a world overcomer!

1Jo 5:11 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.

Thank you Father for your eternal record that states that you have given me eternal life.

1Jo 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *[even]* in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

Thank you Lord that you came and gave me an understanding so that I now know the true Father and the true Son- The true God and Eternal Life.

2Jo 1:2 For the truth's sake, which dwelleth in us, and shall be with us for ever.

Thank you Lord for causing your truth to dwell in me forever,

Jud 1:1 Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *[and]* called:

Thank you Lord that you set me apart as holy and preserved me in Christ.
