Introduction

RIGHTEOUS

(Psa 1:6) For the Lord knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the ungodly shall perish.

The Lord knows and directs my path today.

(Psa 5:12) For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as *with* a shield.

You, O Lord, have blessed me and your favor surrounds me as a shield!

(Psa 14:5) There they are in great fear, For God *is* with the generation of the righteous.

God is with me today!

(Psa 31:18) Let the lying lips be put to silence, Which speak insolent

things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.

Those who speak proud and deceitful things against me will be put to silence!

(Psa 32:11) Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, you righteous; And shout for joy, all *you* upright in heart!

I am glad and rejoice in you Lord! I shout for joy from my heart!

(Psa 33:1) Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! *For* praise from the upright is beautiful.

I rejoice in the Lord today! My praise is beautiful to God.

(Psa 34:15) The eyes of the Lord *are* on the righteous, And His ears *are open* to their cry.

The eyes of the Lord are looking upon me with favor today and His ears are open to when I call upon Him!

(Psa 34:17) *The righteous* cry out, and the Lord hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles.

When I call out to God He hears me and delivers me from all my troubles. God is hearing and delivering me right now!

(Psa 34:19) Many *are* the afflictions of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all.

I have many afflictions come my way, but praise the Lord that He delivers me out of them all! I am delivered from my present afflictions!

(Psa 34:21) Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who hate the righteous shall be condemned.

Those who hate me will be
condemned.

(Psa 37:16) A little that a righteous
man has *is* better than the riches of
many wicked.

What I have right now is better than all
the riches of the wicked.

(Psa 37:17) For the arms of the
wicked shall be broken, But the
Lord upholds the righteous.

The Lord is upholding me today.

(Psa 37:21) The wicked borrows
and does not repay, But the
righteous shows mercy and gives.

I show mercy to others and I am a
giver!

(Psa 37:25) I have been young, and
now am old; Yet I have not seen the

**righteous forsaken, Nor his
descendants begging bread.**

God will never forsake me and my
children will never beg for bread. Me
and my household always have
enough!

**(Psa 37:29) The righteous shall
inherit the land, And dwell in it
forever.**

I have inherited spiritual land and I will
dwell in it forever!

**(Psa 37:30) The mouth of the
righteous speaks wisdom, And his
tongue talks of justice.**

My mouth speaks wisdom and my
tongue talks righteousness.

**(Psa 37:39) But the salvation of the
righteous *is* from the Lord; *He is*
their strength in the time of trouble.**

My salvation is from the Lord and He is my strength in the troubles I am facing.

(Psa 55:22) Cast your burden on the Lord, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

I cast my burden upon the Lord right now and He is sustaining me. He shall never allow me to be moved from my fixed and solid position in Him!

(Psa 58:11) So that men will say, "Surely *there is* a reward for the righteous; Surely He is God who judges in the earth."

Surely, I have a reward in this life and the next!

(Psa 64:10) The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory.

I am glad in the Lord today and I trust Him. I glory in my heart over the greatness of God!

(Psa 68:3) But let the righteous be glad; Let them rejoice before God; Yes, let them rejoice exceedingly.

I am glad today and I rejoice before God. Yes, I am very joyful in my God!

(Psa 72:7) In His days the righteous shall flourish, And abundance of peace, Until the moon is no more.

In my days upon the earth I am flourishing! I have an abundance of peace which will last forever!

(Psa 75:10) "All the horns of the wicked I will also cut off, *But* the horns of the righteous shall be exalted."

I am exalted in strength and authority
in Jesus Christ!

(Psa 92:12) The righteous shall
flourish like a palm tree, He shall
grow like a cedar in Lebanon.

I am flourishing like the palm tree that
is sustained from it's inner core. I am
flourishing from the Spirit of God
inside of me!

(Psa 97:11) Light is sown for the
righteous, And gladness for the
upright in heart.

Light has been sown for me and light
is springing forth in my life and I can
see clearly now! I am very glad in my
heart!

(Psa 97:12) Rejoice in the Lord,
you righteous, And give thanks at
the remembrance of His holy name.

I rejoice in the Lord today! I give thanks at the remembrance of your Holy name!

(Psa 112:4) Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; *He is* gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

Light is arising in my darkness causing it to vanish away! I am gracious, full of compassion, and I am righteous!

(Psa 112:6) Surely he will never be shaken; The righteous will be in everlasting remembrance.

I will never be shaken. I have an everlasting remembrance before God!

(Psa 118:15) The voice of rejoicing and salvation *is* in the tents of the righteous; The right hand of the Lord does valiantly.

I lift my voice in rejoicing over God's salvation in my house today. Jesus has done valiantly for me!

(Psa 118:20) This is the gate of the Lord, Through which the righteous shall enter.

I enter the gate of thanksgiving today!

(Psa 125:3) For the scepter of wickedness shall not rest On the land allotted to the righteous, Lest the righteous reach out their hands to iniquity.

Wickedness shall not rest upon my spiritual and natural property today!

(Psa 140:13) Surely the righteous shall give thanks to Your name; The upright shall dwell in Your presence.

I surely will give you thanks to your name today Lord. I dwell forever in your presence.

(Psa 146:8) The Lord opens *the eyes of the blind*; The Lord raises those who are bowed down; The Lord loves the righteous.

The Lord has opened my eyes and I can now see! The Lord has raised me up to walk straight. The Lord loves me!

(Pro 10:3) The Lord will not allow the righteous soul to famish, But He casts away the desire of the wicked.

God does not permit me to experience my soul to lack. He will always nourish me when I come to Him!

(Pro 10:6) Blessings *are* on the head of the righteous, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.

Blessings are on my head right now! I am blessed wherever I go!

(Pro 10:7) The memory of the righteous *is* blessed, But the name of the wicked will rot.

I have a blessed memory!

(Pro 10:11) The mouth of the righteous *is* a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.

My mouth is a well of life that issues forth life for me and for others!

(Pro 10:16) The labor of the righteous *leads* to life, The wages of the wicked to sin.

My work produces life for me and others!

(Pro 10:20) The tongue of the righteous *is* choice silver; The heart of the wicked *is worth* little.

My tongue is choice silver and speaks of redemption all the day long!

(Pro 10:21) The lips of the righteous feed many, But fools die for lack of wisdom.

My lips feed many people with good things!

(Pro 10:24) The fear of the wicked will come upon him, And the desire of the righteous will be granted.

My desire is being granted right now because I delight in the Lord and He gives me the desires of my heart!

(Pro 10:25) When the whirlwind passes by, the wicked *is no more*, But the righteous *has* an everlasting foundation.

I have an everlasting foundation in God!

(Pro 10:28) The hope of the righteous *will be* gladness, But the expectation of the wicked will perish.

I only expect gladness and goodness!

(Pro 10:30) The righteous will never be removed, But the wicked will not inhabit the earth.

I shall never be removed from my place in God!

(Pro 10:31) The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom, But the perverse tongue will be cut out.

My mouth is bringing forth wisdom today!

(Pro 10:32) The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, But the mouth of the wicked *what is* perverse.

I know and say the acceptable thing in every situation!

(Pro 11:8) The righteous is delivered from trouble, And it comes to the wicked instead.

I am delivered from trouble and it comes upon the wicked instead of me!

(Pro 11:9) The hypocrite with *his* mouth destroys his neighbor, But through knowledge the righteous will be delivered.

I am being delivered by what I know today!

(Pro 11:10) When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices; And

when the wicked perish, *there is* jubilation.

It is going well with me and my city is rejoicing!

(Pro 11:21) *Though they join* forces, the wicked will not go unpunished; **But the posterity of the righteous will be delivered.**

My children and future generations will be delivered!

(Pro 11:23) The desire of the righteous *is* only good, *But* the expectation of the wicked *is* wrath.

My desire today is only good. Wicked desires have been replaced by good desires from the Lord!

(Pro 11:28) He who trusts in his riches will fall, **But the righteous will flourish like foliage.**

I am flourishing like green foliage!

(Pro 11:30) The fruit of the righteous *is a* tree of life, And he who wins souls *is* wise.

My fruit is a tree of life giving life to all that partake of it!

(Pro 11:31) If the righteous will be recompensed on the earth, How much more the ungodly and the sinner.

I am being recompensed in this life for the good that I have done!

(Pro 12:3) A man is not established by wickedness, But the root of the righteous cannot be moved.

My root cannot be removed. I am fixed, steady, and stable today!

(Pro 12:5) The thoughts of the righteous *are* right, *But* the

counsels of the wicked *are* deceitful.

All my thoughts are right. Wrong thoughts are being replaced with right thoughts!

(Pro 12:7) The wicked are overthrown and *are* no more, But the house of the righteous will stand.

My house will stand no matter what comes!

(Pro 12:10) A righteous *man* regards the life of his animal, But the tender mercies of the wicked *are* cruel.

I regard the life of my animals.

(Pro 12:12) The wicked covet the catch of evil *men*, But the root of the righteous yields *fruit*.

My life yields abundant fruit!

(Pro 12:13) The wicked is ensnared by the transgression of *his* lips, But the righteous will come through trouble.

I am coming through trouble better than I went into it!

(Pro 12:21) No grave trouble will overtake the righteous, But the wicked shall be filled with evil.

No grave trouble will overtake me and defeat me!

(Pro 13:5) A righteous *man* hates lying, But a wicked *man* is loathsome and comes to shame.

I hate lying and put it far from me!

(Pro 13:9) The light of the righteous rejoices, But the lamp of the wicked will be put out.

I rejoice in my spirit no matter what is going on.

(Pro 13:21) Evil pursues sinners, But to the righteous, good shall be repaid.

Good is being repaid to me!

(Pro 13:22) A good *man* leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

I will leave an inheritance to my children's children. The wealth of the sinner has been laid up for me and is being delivered to me today!

(Pro 13:25) The righteous eats to the satisfying of his soul, But the stomach of the wicked shall be in want.

I eat to the satisfaction of my soul.

(Pro 14:19) The evil will bow before the good, And the wicked at the gates of the righteous.

Evil bows down to me. I have authority over evil!

(Pro 14:32) The wicked is banished in his wickedness, But the righteous has a refuge in his death.

I have an eternal refuge in my death which is Jesus Christ!

(Pro 15:6) *In* the house of the righteous *there is* much treasure, But in the revenue of the wicked is trouble.

I have much treasure in my house!

(Pro 15:28) The heart of the righteous studies how to answer,

But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.

I study how to answer and come up with the right answer each time!

(Pro 15:29) The Lord *is* far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.

The Lord always hears my prayers and answers them!

(Pro 16:13) Righteous lips *are* the delight of kings, And they love him who speaks *what is* right.

My lips are a delight to King Jesus!

(Pro 18:10) The name of the Lord *is* a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.

I run into the name of the Lord and I am safe right now!

(Pro 20:7) The righteous *man* walks in his integrity; His children *are* blessed after him.

I walk in integrity and my children are blessed after me!

(Pro 21:18) The wicked *shall be* a ransom for the righteous, And the unfaithful for the upright.

Jesus became a curse for me to ransom me.

(Pro 21:26) He covets greedily all day long, But the righteous gives and does not spare.

I give and I do not spare. I have more than enough to give each and every time!

(Pro 24:16) For a righteous *man* may fall seven times And rise again, But the wicked shall fall by calamity.

I may fall seven times but I get up every time!

(Pro 28:1) The wicked flee when no one pursues, But the righteous are bold as a lion.

I am bold as a lion. I fear no man. I only fear God!

(Pro 28:12) When the righteous rejoice, *there is* great glory; But when the wicked arise, men hide themselves.

I am rejoicing and experiencing God's glory!

(Pro 29:6) By transgression an evil man is snared, But the righteous sings and rejoices.

I am singing and rejoicing!

(Pro 29:7) The righteous considers the cause of the poor, *But* the wicked does not understand *such* knowledge.

I consider the cause of the poor and help them.

(Pro 29:16) When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increases; *But* the righteous will see their fall.

I will see the fall of the wicked with my own eyes.

(Pro 29:27) An unjust man *is* an abomination to the righteous, *And he who is* upright in the way *is* an abomination to the wicked.

The unjust ways of man are an abomination to me!

UPRIGHT

Psa 7:10 My defense *is* of God,
Who saves the upright in heart.

God is my defense and He is saving
me right now!

Psa 11:7 For the Lord *is* righteous,
He loves righteousness; His
countenance beholds the upright.

God's countenance and grace is upon
me right now!

Psa 36:10 Oh, continue Your
lovingkindness to those who know
You, And Your righteousness to
the upright in heart.

God's righteousness continues in my
life today!

Psa 37:18 The Lord knows the days of the upright, And their inheritance shall be forever.

The Lord knows my days! My inheritance will last forever!

Psa 37:37 Mark the blameless *man*, and observe the upright; For the future of *that man is* peace.

My future is only peace!

Psa 64:10 The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory.

I glory in God today!

Psa 94:15 But judgment will return to righteousness, And all the upright in heart will follow it.

I follow righteousness today. God has returned judgment concerning me and it returned as righteous!

Psa 97:11 Light is sown for the righteous, And gladness for the upright in heart.

Light and gladness has been sown for me! I am reaping the harvest of them now!

Psa 112:2 His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed.

I am blessed and my generation of believers are blessed!

Psa 112:4 Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness; *He is* gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

Light is arising upon me today!

Psa 125:4 Do good, O Lord, to *those who are good*, And to *those who are upright* in their hearts.

God is doing only good to me today!

Psa 140:13 Surely the righteous shall give thanks to Your name; The upright shall dwell in Your presence.

I dwell in God's presence and will forever!

(Pro 2:7) He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; *He is a shield* to those who walk uprightly;

God has stored up wisdom for me. I access that wisdom today! God is a shield to me!

(Pro 2:21) For the upright will dwell in the land, And the blameless will remain in it;

I will dwell in the land of God and I will remain in it!

(Pro 3:32) For the perverse *person is* an abomination to the Lord, But His secret counsel *is* with the upright.

God's secret counsel is with me today!

(Pro 10:29) The way of the Lord *is* strength for the upright, But destruction *will come* to the workers of iniquity.

God's ways is giving me strength right now!

(Pro 11:3) The integrity of the upright will guide them, But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them.

Righteousness and integrity are guiding me today!

(Pro 11:6) The righteousness of the upright will deliver them, But the unfaithful will be caught by *their* lust.

Righteousness is delivering me!

(Pro 11:11) By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted, But it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.

My city is exalted because of me!

(Pro 12:6) The words of the wicked *are*, "Lie in wait for blood," But the mouth of the upright will deliver them.

My mouth delivers me!

(Pro 14:9) Fools mock at sin, But among the upright *there is* favor.

I have the favor of God on my life and everywhere I go today!

(Pro 14:11) The house of the wicked will be overthrown, But the tent of the upright will flourish.

My house and body are flourishing!

(Pro 15:8) The sacrifice of the wicked *is* an abomination to the Lord, But the prayer of the upright *is* His delight.

My prayer is God's delight!

(Pro 15:19) The way of the lazy *man is* like a hedge of thorns, But the way of the upright *is* a highway.

My way is a highway leading towards blessing!

(Pro 16:17) The highway of the upright *is* to depart from evil; He

who keeps his way preserves his soul.

I am on a highway moving speedily away from evil!

(Pro 21:18) The wicked *shall be* a ransom for the righteous, And the unfaithful for the upright.

Jesus was my ransom because He became cursed for me!

(Pro 21:29) A wicked man hardens his face, But *as for* the upright, he establishes his way.

I am establishing my way today!

(Pro 29:10) The bloodthirsty hate the blameless, But the upright seek his well-being.

I seek the well-being of all people!

JUST

(Pro 3:33) The curse of the Lord *is* on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of the just.

God is blessing my home!

(Pro 4:18) But the path of the just *is* like the shining sun, That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day.

My life is getting brighter and brighter and getting better and better!

(Pro 9:9) Give *instruction* to a wise *man*, and he will be still wiser; Teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.

When I am taught I always increase in learning!

(Pro 21:15) *It is* a joy for the just to do justice, But destruction *will come* to the workers of iniquity.

It is a joy for me to do right!
